ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

It appearing that on November 23, 1971, the Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation which suspended the effective date of certain tariff sheets, being Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 213-W and 214-W, providing for service in an area outside the filed service area, filed by Del Este Water Company under Advice Letter No. 45, until February 17, 1972, and

It further appearing that a decision in the matter could not be rendered by said date of February 17, 1972, and

The Commission having found that the period of suspension of said tariff sheets should be extended; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the effective date of certain tariff sheets, being Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 213-W and 214-W, filed by Del Este Water Company under Advice Letter No. 45, is extended to and including May 15, 1972, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith upon Del Este Water Company.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
