ORDER DENYING INTERIM RELIEF
AND SETTING HEARING

By verified complaint, Complainant requests that the Commission afford it immediate interim relief in the form of an order directing Defendant telephone utility to permit Complainant's "Divert-a-call" units to be connected to Defendant's telephone system without a "common arrangement" and to prevent Defendant from interfering with the reconnection of a "Divert-a-call" unit to a particular customer. Complainant further requests a hearing on the need for a "common arrangement" and what Complainant alleges to be a discriminatory rate for this "common arrangement."

The Commission is of the opinion that it is not possessed of sufficient facts to grant the immediate relief requested by Complainant. Therefore, Complainant's request for immediate interim relief will be denied.

In view of the asserted urgency set forth in the complaint the Commission deems it appropriate to set this matter for early hearing. Hearings on this matter will be held at the Commission



ORDER


1. Complainant's request for immediate relief is denied.
