ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

By verified complaint, Complainant requests that the Commission afford it immediate interim relief in the form of an order requiring Defendant telephone company to cease and desist "from interfering with the installation and performance of Complainant's Extenda Wats System". Said complaint alleges that Defendant telephone company has threatened to disconnect a telephone subscriber, Warner Brothers, which is using Complainant's Extenda Wats System without an interconnecting device provided by Defendant.

The Commission is of the opinion that it is not possessed of sufficient facts to grant the immediate order requested by Complainant. Therefore, Complainant's request for a cease and desist order pending hearing will be denied.

Complainant has alleged that it could redesign its Extenda Wats System in ninety days so as to be compatible with Defendant's interconnecting arrangement. Therefore, the Commission will issue an Order to Show Cause why Defendant should not be restrained from interfering with the operation of Complainant's Extenda Wats Systems at Warner Brothers for a period of ninety days to permit




such redesign of Complainant's system, or until further order of the Commission. Hearing on this Order to Show Cause will be held at the Commission Courtroom, State Building, 107 S. Broadway Street, Los Angeles, California, on March 14, 1972, at 10:00 a.m., before Examiner John R. Gillanders.


ORDER

1. Complainant's request for an immediate cease and desist order is denied.
2. Defendant is ordered to appear at the time and place indicated herein and there show cause why it should not be restrained from interfering with Complainant's Extenda Wats System at Warner Brothers for a period of ninety days or until further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof. The Secretary is ordered to make personal service of this order on Defendant.
