ORDER AMENDING APPLICATION

Petitioner, City of Riverside, requests an order amending the subject application by deleting paragraph I of the original application, filed April 24, 1967, and substituting therefor the following new paragraph I:

"This is a petition of the First class as provided for in California Public Utilities Code Section No. 1403."

Petitioner alleges that the City of Riverside is now empowered by its charter to issue revenue bonds without the necessity of placing the issue before the City's electors. Southwest Water Company, by letter to the City of Riverside dated February 2, 1972, states that it does not oppose the requested amendment.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the subject application, filed April 24, 1967, be, and it hereby is, amended by deleting paragraph I thereof and inserting in its place a new paragraph I reading as follows:
