ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On reading the verified complaint of Complainant, a certificated charter party carrier of passengers, in which it is alleged that Defendant is operating as a charter party carrier of passengers in competition with Complainant, and that Defendant does not hold the requisite authority from this Commission; and

It appearing that Complainant is being injured by the alleged unauthorized operations of Defendant; and

Such alleged conduct of Defendant being contrary to the provisions of the California Public Utilities Code; and

Complainant having requested an order requiring Defendant to cease and desist from said unlawful operations;

NOW THEREFORE, Defendant Santa Rosa Y.M.C.A. is hereby ordered to cease and desist from providing unauthorized charter party passenger operations to the public. This order shall continue until further order of the Commission.

It is further ordered that Defendant Santa Rosa Y.M.C.A. shall appear before Examiner Fraser in Room 107A at the Planning Department Conference Room, County Administration Building, 2555 Mendocino Avenue, Santa Rosa, California, the 28th day of February, 1972

at 10 a.m., at which time Defendant shall show cause why this order to cease and desist from conducting unauthorized charter party passenger carrier business should not remain in effect until a decision on the merits of the complaint has been reached. Public necessity requires that this show cause hearing be held on less than 10 days notice in order to protect the rights of the parties.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof. The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be personally served on Defendant.
