SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 61613, dated March 7, 1961, in this proceeding James H. Carr and Charles A. Carr, doing business as CARR BROS. OXNARD TRUCKING SERVICE, were granted an in-lieu certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code.


Upon the death of Charles A. Carr, Letters Testamentary were issued appointing his widow, Patricia I. Carr, Executrix of his estate. A request has been filed with the Commission to reissue the certificate of public convenience and necessity to James H. Carr and Patricia I. Carr, Executrix of the Estate of Charles A. Carr. A public hearing is not necessary.


Therefore, good cause appearing:


