O R D E R

The State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of Reed Avenue under the track of Sacramento Northern Railway in the Town of Bryte in the County of Yolo at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8B-1.81-B.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and a copy of said agreement together with plans of said crossing approved by the railroad company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.


Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D.


Walkway areas adjacent to the railroad track shall be maintained free of obstructions and shall promptly be restored to their original condition in the event of damage during construction.


Upon completion, the existing grade separation of Reed Avenue, Crossing No. 8B-1.8-B located adjacent to the authorized crossing shall be abandoned and physically closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless the time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
