OPINION AND ORDER

San Francisco Warehouse Company requests authority to further suspend operations as a public utility warehouseman in 10,000 square feet of space in Emeryville to February 1, 1973, or until the date service is resumed prior to February 1, 1973.

By Decision No. 71992, dated February 7, 1967, in Application No. 48940, the prescriptive authority of applicant as determined by Commission order dated July 12, 1960 in Case No. 6612 was suspended until February 1, 1968, pending an attempt by applicant to find suitable space in Emeryville. The suspension was further extended by subsequent Commission decisions.

It is alleged that applicant has not yet been able to find suitable space in Emeryville and a further suspension to February 1, 1973 is requested.

Because the operative right has been suspended five consecutive times since 1967, which should have afforded applicant ample time to find suitable space, the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service as a public utility warehouseman in Emeryville.

Applicant's attorney has informed the Commission, by letter, that applicant makes no request for a public hearing and is willing to comply with the Commission's finding in the matter.



IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive right authorizing San Francisco Warehouse Company to operate as a public utility warehouseman in 10,000 square feet of space in Emeryville is hereby revoked.


2. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the revocation of authority as set forth in ordering paragraph 1 hereof.

The Secretary of the Commission shall cause a copy of this order to be personally served upon applicant. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after such service.
