OPINION AND ORDER

By this application American Transfer Co. sought extension of previously authorized authority to charge less than the minimum rates on the transportation of glass for PPG Industries from Fresno to points in the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area.

Decision No. 79484, dated December 14, 1971, in this application, authorized a four-month extension of the authority pending a public hearing, due to a protest filed by the California Trucking Association. Applicant has since submitted additional cost data, and the California Trucking Association has withdrawn its protest.


It now appears that applicant should be granted an extension of the authority for a full year. A public hearing is not necessary.


The Commission finds that the sought rate is reasonable, and that the sought authority should be extended for a full year without hearing.


IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decision No. 79484, in this application, is extended to expire with April 14, 1973.
