ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

George B. Shore, an individual, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Hollister.

George B. Shore, owner of Tres Pinos Grain and Supply, Hollister, has informed the Commission by letter dated February 10, 1972, that "Tres Pinos Grain & Supply has been out of the warehousing end of the business pertaining to public utilities for four years".

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that revocation of the prescriptive operative right would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and that the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by George B. Shore, an individual, for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Hollister as stated in Decision No. 70746, dated May 24, 1966, in Application No. 43361, is hereby revoked.

2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Tres Pinos Grain and Supply from California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 38, Cal.P.U.C. No. 203, on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon George B. Shore or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
