SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 79008 dated August 10, 1971, as amended by Decision No. 79302 dated November 9, 1971, in the above proceeding provided, among other things, for the establishment of exception ratings on Sheet Steel Containers in Section 2-D of Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1.

It has come to the Commission's attention that certain of the minimum weights relating to the aforementioned exception ratings were published in error and a governing note was omitted.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary corrections should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Decision No. 79008, as amended should be further amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective April 15, 1972, Fifth Revised Page 28-A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.


3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than April 15, 1972; tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.


4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.


5. In all other respects, Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
