ORDER VACATING ORDER STAYING OPERATIVE EFFECT OF DECISION NO. 79296 AND SUSPENDING AND REVOKING OPERATING AUTHORITY

On March 8, 1972, the petition filed in the Supreme Court of the State of California (L.A.No. 29962, <u>Armored Transport, Inc.</u> and <u>Valley Armored Transport, Inc.</u> vs. <u>Public Utilities Commission</u>) for writ of review of Decision No. 79296 in the above-entitled proceeding was denied, and good cause appearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Decision No. 79747 which stayed the operative effect of Decision No. 79296 is vacated.
- 2. The highway contract carrier permit of Armored Transport, Inc., and the highway contract carrier permit and radial highway common carrier permit of Valley Armored Transport, Inc., are suspended March 31, 1972 and revoked May 1, 1972, unless on or before such dates Transportation Rate Fund fees owing this Commission in the amount of \$767.89 by Armored Transport, Inc., and \$22.16 by Valley Armored Transport, Inc., are paid; in which event the suspended permits shall be reinstated.
