ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By letter dated March 1, 1972, the San Diego Economy Line, Inc., requests a one-year extension of time in which to restore service to its Route No. 1 (San Diego-Homeland) because of continuing financial difficulties. Applicant also has a pending request for fare increase in Application No. 52675.

The Commission authorized the San Diego Economy Line, Inc. to suspend operations on its Route No. 1 (San Diego-Homeland) until April 1, 1972 by Decision No. 78684.

Applicant is currently operating Route No. 2 (College Grove-San Ysidro) six days a week and does not desire to abandon Route No. 1.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Economy Line, Inc. is granted an extension of time in which to restore service to its Route No. 1 (San Diego-Homeland) to April 1, 1973.

In all other respects, Decision No. 78684 dated May 18, 1971 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
