O P I N I O N

East Bay Drayage & Warehouse Co., presently providing service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities with certain exceptions between points in the San Francisco Territory, requests that its operating authority be amended by excluding therefrom the transportation of hypochlorite solution and related commodities from Oakland.

It is alleged that applicant wishes to succeed to the service presently being provided by Coast Drayage for the transportation of sodium hypochlorite solution and related commodities from the Oakland plant of The Clorox Company to points in northern and central California; that such service would be performed pursuant to applicant's permitted authority; and that if applicant's certificate is amended as herein requested an appropriate application will be filed requesting authority to deviate from the minimum rates for such shipments.

After consideration the Commission finds that the requested authority would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 61448 in Application No. 42734 is hereby amended by incorporating First Revised Page 2, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, in place of Original Page 2.

2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

3. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment.
4. Petroleum products, in bulk, in tank vehicles.
5. Fresh fruits and vegetables.
6. Sodium hypochlorite solution, and sodium hydroxide solution, cleaning compounds, animal litter (chopped alfalfa pellets), in bags, and laundry bleach (dry) when transported in mixed shipments with sodium hypochlorite solution, that originate at Oakland, California, and empty pallets returning to Oakland which was the origin of the outbound palletized shipment of said commodity or commodities. This exclusion does not apply when sodium hypochlorite solution is transported in mixed shipments with commodities authorized to be transported under this authority, except as provided herein, or when interlined with a water, rail or motor carrier for further transportation.
