ORDER DENYING REHEARING

California Trucking Association having filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 79491, the Commission having considered each and every allegation therein and good cause having not been made to appear,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Rehearing of Decision No. 79491 is hereby denied.
2. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective April 12, 1972, Supplement 86, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
3. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 31606, as amended, are hereby authorized to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.






4. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the tariff supplement incorporated in this order.

5. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

6. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
