SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 58738, dated July 14, 1959, in this proceeding, Superior Vacuum Trucks of Long Beach, acquired a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport petroleum and petroleum products in vacuum tank trucks between various points and places in the State as a petroleum irregular route carrier. This authority was originally granted by Decision No. 51454, dated May 10, 1955, in Application No. 36499 to Superior Vacuum Truck Service.

The applicant, having financial problems, heretofore requested authority to suspend service as a petroleum irregular route carrier for one year. Authority to suspend petroleum irregular ular route carrier operations to December 1, 1971 was granted by Decision No. 78011, dated December 1, 1970, as amended by Decision No. 78166, dated January 13, 1971.

The suspension period has terminated but the corporation has failed to resume operations or request further suspension of operations despite repeated requests of the staff to dispose of the matter.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier acquired by Superior Vacuum Trucks of Long Beach by Decision No. 58738, dated July 14, 1959, in Application No. 41097 is hereby revoked effective May 15, 1972, unless on or before such date service is resumed or an application is filed to further suspend the certificate.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of this order to be made by certified mail upon Superior Vacuum Trucks of Long Beach.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
