SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 79451, dated December 14, 1971, in this proceeding found that revision of the hourly vehicle unit rates for combinations of equipment consisting of a tractor and trailing unit to reflect the rates for 2-axle trailing units rather than 1-axle trailing units will be just and reasonable, and concluded that such tariff change should be accomplished concurrently with the adjustment of rate levels in Minimum Rate Tariff 15 pursuant to Petition No. 46 in Case No. 7783 and that such tariff changes would be made in the order in said proceeding.

Through inadvertence Decision No. 79627, dated January 18, 1972, in Case No. 7783, Petition No. 46, failed to incorporate the rate adjustments referred to above. Said adjustments will be made pursuant to the order which follows.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 15 (Appendix B to Decision No. 65072, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective May 13, 1972, First Revised Page 24-E, First Revised Page 24-F and First Revised Page 24-G, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

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- 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 65072, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein of said decision.
- 3. Tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than May 13, 1972, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public; such tariff publications as are required shall be made effective not later than May 13, 1972; and as to tariff publications which are authorized but not required, the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order.
- 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 5. In all other respects Decision No. 65072, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
