In the Matter of the Application of GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, a corporation, for an Order authorizing it to sell, transfer and convey certain of its real property located in Orange County to the County of Orange.

OPINION AND ORDER

General Telephone Company of California (General) requests authorization under Section 851 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California to transfer, sell, and convey to the County of Orange (County) certain parcel of real property described in paragraph III of the application and shown on the map attached as Exhibit B, located in Orange County. The agreed consideration is \$11,500, which applicant and County believe to be a fair and reasonable price.

General is an owner of certain real property which County desires to utilize for road purposes. County is planning to construct a public library nearby and there is no public road which would give access to members of the public to the site of the library. General currently uses the property as an underground cable and conduit entrance to the adjoining central office. General will reserve a perpetual easement which will permit the public utility use currently being made of the property. Therefore, the loss to applicant of the property to be sold to County will not impair the efficiency of General's operations.

The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of value of the property herein authorized to be sold.
