ORDER DENYING INTERIM RELIEF

Complainant filed a request for an interim order requiring that Defendant cease and desist from conducting unauthorized operations as a passenger stage corporation pending a final order in this proceeding.

The Complaint herein is similar in nature and allegations to that filed by the same Complainant against the same Defendant in Case No. 9301. Complainant has requested dismissal of that complaint by letter dated March 24, 1972. Complainant's request for interim order also indicates that issues which appear to be relevant to the instant proceeding were matters of evidence in Application No. 52862.

In view of the past history of contested filings involving these same parties the Commission is reluctant to make any ex parte order in this proceeding on its own initiative, and Complainant

has not requested such action. A request for interim relief in the instant proceeding may be made to the Examiner.

Complainant's request for interim relief is denied without prejudice to its renewal.
