ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Pacific Gas and Electric Company by letter received April 17, 1972, has requested an extension of time to comply with ordering paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 78186 for filing a study covering service to schools including load characteristics, cost studies and other pertinent data relating to the rate level for such service. Because of unexpected problems encountered in processing load characteristic information, complete data was not obtained for the 1971 summer and winter period, and the company will be unable to meet the April 28, 1972 date. In order to properly evaluate the load characteristics of schools in relationship to other classes, it is now necessary to extend the load research program through the 1972 summer and winter period. Pacific Gas and Electric Company has requested an extension of time to April 27, 1973.

It appearing to the Commission that this request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 78186 is modified to read as follows:

"2. On or before April 27, 1973, Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall file a study covering service to schools including load characteristics, cost studies and other pertinent data relating to the rate level for such service."
