

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 62690, dated October 17, 1961, in this proceeding Jack O. Murch, an individual doing business as, American Transportation Company, was granted an in lieu certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway Common carrier as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code.

Upon the death of Jack O. Murch, Letters Testamentary were issued appointing his widow, Margaret Green Murch, Executrix of his estate. A request has been filed with the Commission to reissue the certificate of public convenience and necessity to Margaret Green Murch, Executrix of the Estate of Jack O. Murch. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 62690 is hereby amended by substituting the name of Margaret Green Murch, Executrix of the Estate of Jack O. Murch, in place and stead of Jack O. Murch in Ordering Paragraph 1 thereof.

2. Margaret Green Murch, Executrix of the Estate of Jack O. Murch shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates and rules governing the common carrier operations herein to show she has adopted or established, as her own, said rates and rules. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80-Series.
