SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 75951 dated July 22, 1969 in Application No. 51157 the City of Carlsbad was authorized, among other things, to construct Cannon Road at grade across tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. The time for completion of the city's project was extended to August 11, 1971 by Decision Nc. 77432 and to August 11, 1972 by Decision No. 79066.

By this petition the city requests authority for the construction of a crossing 82 feet in width in lieu of 64 feet as previously authorized. In addition, the city requests an extension of time to complete this project to December 31, 1972.

IT IS ORDERED that the first sentence of the second paragraph of the order in Decision No. 75951 which now reads as follows:

> "Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Width of crossing shall be not less than 82 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time limit within which the city may exercise the authority granted is hereby extended to December 31, 1972.

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In all other respects Decision No. 75951 shall remain in full force and effect.
