ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This order deals with a request of Lloyd Hendricks Wood for authority to assess hourly rates for the transportation of sodium chloride in bulk in dump truck equipment between points in Los Angeles and Orange Counties for Leslie Salt Company, Ocean Salt Company and Western Salt Company instead of the Commission established distance rates in cents per 100 pounds which apply as minimum for said transportation.

By Decision No. 78876 dated June 29, 1971, applicant was authorized to charge hourly rates as sought for a period of 6 months. Such authority was granted as an interim action pending further consideration and decision after public hearing on the matter.

Lloyd Hendricks Wood has since informed the Commission, by letter dated April 17, 1972, that he does not wish to proceed with the prosecution of his application, and he asks that the application be dismissed.
