O P I N I O N

By order in Case No. 9116, Decision No. 78599, Joseph N. Le Bow, doing business as Desert Empire Express, was ordered to curtail his operations or seek additional authority to cover his operations. By Application No. 52808, applicant requested an appropriate extension of his common carrier certificate authority. Decision No. 79327, signed November 16, 1971, granted the requested extension.

Based on these facts, it is concluded that the Commission investigation in Case No. 9116 should be discontinued.
