OPINION

By Decision No. 64664 dated December 13, 1962, in Application No. 44947, A-C Coach Lines, Inc., was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Northrop Aircraft Corporation's Ventura Plant and the San Fernando Service area.

On or about January 1, 1963, A-C COACH LINES abandoned service and ceased operations. Following this, Great Western Stages was authorized to serve the area by Decision No. 77013, dated March 31, 1970, in Application No. 51543.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that these matters constitute sufficient reason for the revocation of the operating authority granted by Decision No. 64664.

The Commission, therefore, concludes that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to conduct operations as a passenger stage corporation granted to A-C COACH LINES, INC., should be revoked.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation for the portion between Northrop Aircraft, Ventura Plant and San Fernando Valley authorized by Decision No. 64664 in Application No. 44947, is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of A-C COACH LINES, INC., at 5719 Sepulveda Blvd., Van Nuys, CA 94101, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this Order shall be the twentieth day after the above mailing of a copy of this Order to A-C COACH LINES, INC., unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this Order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this Order shall be stayed until further Order of the Commission.
