ORDER REVOKING OPERATING AUTHORITY

W. A. Peppers has submitted a letter to the Commission stating that for the past five years he has operated completly within the city limits of Napa and has experienced great economic loss. Mr. Peppers requests that his certificate of public convenience and necessity be revoked.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the Certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.
