ORDER REVOKING OPERATING AUTHORITY

W. A. Peppers conducts operations as a passenger stage corporation as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code pursuant to authority granted by Decision No. 54324 dated December 27, 1956, in Application No. 33425, as later amended by Decision No. 56855 dated June 17, 1958, in Application No. 39943, and acquired by applicant by Decision No. 53010, dated February 17, 1959, in Application No. 40466.

W. A. Peppers has submitted a letter to the Commission stating that for the past five years he has operated completely within the city limits of Napa and has experienced great economic loss. Mr. Peppers requests that his certificate of public convenience and necessity be revoked.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the Certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to conduct operations as a passenger stage corporation granted by Decision No. 54324 dated December 27, 1956, in Application No. 33425, as later amended by Decision No. 56855 dated June 17,

1950, in Application No. 39943 is hereby revoked.

2. All tariffs issued by or on behalf of W. A. Peppers, are hereby canceled. A copy of this Order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this Order to W. A. Peppers at 1051 Soscol Avenue, Napa, California, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this Order shall be the twentieth day after the date hereof, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this Order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this Order shall be stayed until further Order of the Commission.
