O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of State Route 5 and Riverside Boulevard under the tracks of Southern Pacific Transportation Company in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AU-92.0-B.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and a copy of said agreement together with plans of said crossing approved by the affected railroad company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, costs of construction and maintenance shall be determined as provided by law.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D. Walkway areas adjacent to the railroad tracks shall be in accordance with General Order No. 118.

Upon completion, the existing grade separation of Riverside Boulevard and Southern Pacific Transportation Company tracks,

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Crossing No. AU-91.9-B, located 500 feet northerly of the authorized crossing, shall be physically removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless the time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
