O P I N I O N

Windsor Utility Corp. requests authority to discontinue public utility water service in the community of Windsor, Sonoma County.

It is alleged that the water system, which serves 20 customers, was acquired by Windsor County Water District, a political subdivision of the State of California, at a public foreclosure sale for nonpayment of franchise taxes on a bid of \$1,551; that the district operates a complete water supply, treatment and distribution system, which generally parallels the water system of Windsor Utility Corp.; and that the district's water system will be made available to the customers of Windsor Utility Corp.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require the continued public utility water service by Windsor Utility Corp. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Concurrent with the commencement of service by Windsor County Water District, Windsor Utility Corp. shall stand relieved of its public utility obligations and may discontinue water service in the community of Windsor, Sonoma County.

2. Within thirty days after the commencement of service by Windsor County Water District applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
