ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 78864, dated June 29, 1971, American Transport System, Inc., was authorized to suspend service as a petroleum irregular route carrier until June 30, 1972. Applicant requests that the suspension be extended to June 30, 1973. It is alleged that applicant is still experiencing problems relating to the acquisition of equipment, insurance and making arrangements with customers for service.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The suspension authorized by Decision No. 78864, dated June 29, 1971, is hereby extended to June 30, 1973, subject to the same conditions contained therein.
2. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public,
