OPINION AND ORDER ON REHEARING

By Decision No. 79357, dated November 22, 1971, the Commission without hearing granted Petition for Modification No. 104 of Wilbur-Ellis Company by establishing exception ratings on "Bentonite" in Exception Ratings Tariff 1. Petitions by California Manufacturers Association and by Industrial Minerals Co. for rehearing were granted by Decision No. 79646. The exception ratings on "Bentonite" were suspended by Decision No. 79513. Hearing in the matter was scheduled for Monday, May 22, 1972, before Examiner Thompson at San Francisco.

On Friday, May 19, 1972, too late to provide notice of removal from calendar, a letter was received from Wilbur-Ellis Company asking that its petition for the exception ratings on "Bentonite" be withdrawn. At the hearing there were no appearances and this letter was read into the record by the Examiner.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The order in Decision No. 79357, dated November 22, 1971, is rescinded.

2. Exception Ratings Tariff 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 29, 1972, Supplement 15, Thirty-Fourth Revised Page 3, and Third Revised Page 17, attached hereto and by this reference made a part thereof.

3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than July 29, 1972.

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
