SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Hills Transportation Co., a corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. The Interstate Commerce Commission by the Certificate of Registration issued in Docket No. MC-107841 (Sub No. 3), amended its records to reflect applicant's doing business as "CONTAINERFREIGHT."

Hills Transportation Co. has submitted a copy of the amended Certificate of Registration and a copy of a Fictitious Name Statement filed with the County Clerk's Office, Los Angeles County. A request having been filed by Hills Transportation Co., its certificate will be amended to show the fictitious trade name. Hills Transportation Co. will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-Series. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificates of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 62196 in Application No. 43040, Decision No. 61390 in Application No. 42905 and Decision No. 59987 in Application No. 41308 to Hills Transportation Co., a corporation, authorizing it to operate as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code are amended to include the fictitious name "Containerfreight."

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the date hereof, and no not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Hills Transportation Co. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by General Order No. 80-Series.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
