OPINION

Hornitos Telephone Co. seeks authority to enter into a Loan Agreement for the borrowing of \$125,000, and to issue notes and execute and deliver a mortgage and supplemental mortgages in accordance with such agreement.

Applicant is a California corporation furnishing telephone service in and about the community of Hornitos in Mariposa County. For the twelve months ended June 30, 1971, it reports operating revenues and net income in the respective amounts of \$72,142 and \$10,443. Its reported balance sheet as of June 30, 1971, is summarized as follows:

The application indicates that the company has continued to experience increasing demand for added and higher grades of telephone service, necessitating substantial additions to central office equipment and outside plant facilities at an estimated cost in excess of \$125,000.

For the purpose of providing funds to finance, in part, such additions, applicant has negotiated a Loan Agreement with Stromberg-Carlson Corporation whereby short-term borrowings in an aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$125,000 would be made available as needed and would be evidenced by demand notes. Interest on said demand notes would be payable monthly at a rate per annum 2-1/2% over the New York City Bank prime interest rate in effect on the first day of each month. On or before December 31, 1973, a final note in the principal amount of not exceeding \$125,000 would be substituted for said demand notes and would be secured by a mortgage and one or more supplemental mortgages. The final note would be repayable in 240 monthly installments, together with interest at the rate of 9-1/2% per annum on unpaid principal.

3. This order shall become effective when Hornitos Telephone Co. has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$250.
