THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

O.N.C. Motor Freight System (O.N.C.), a corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by this Commission. O.N.C. has filed a copy of a petition which has been accepted by the Interstate Commerce Commission changing the corporate name. A petition for change of corporate name having been filed by O.N.C. Motor Freight System, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name, "O.N.C. FREIGHT SYSTEMS," and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:





1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 79364, in Application No. 41429, is amended by substituting the name "O.N.C. FREIGHT SYSTEMS" in the place and stead of "O.N.C. MOTOR FREIGHT SYSTEM."

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, O.N.C. FREIGHT SYSTEMS shall amend its tariffs

on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
