## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Order in Decision No. 79160, dated September 21, 1971, authorized the State of California Department of Public Works to widen and improve the crossing of State Route 139 at grade with track of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company, identified as Crossing No. CFA-533.3-C, near Hatfield in Siskiyou County.

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company, by Petition for Modification filed with the Commission on May 4, 1972, requests authority to replace the existing floodlights with two modern luminaries which will be controlled by a photocell to function continually from dusk to dawn. Cost of replacing existing floodlights with two modern luminaries will be borne by petitioner.

The State of California Department of Public Works has informed the Commission by letter dated June 7, 1972, that there is no objection to petitioner's request.

IT IS ORDERED that the last sentence of the first paragraph in Decision No. 79160 which reads as follows:

"Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material augmented with existing train-actuated flood lights."

shall be modified to read as follows:

Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1

A.52733 DY crossing signs (General Order No. 75-E) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material augmented with two modern luminaries controlled by a photocell to function continually from dusk to dawn. In all other respects Decision No. 79160 shall remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
