SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 76983 dated March 24, 1970 in Application No. 51665 the City of Fullerton was authorized, among other things, to construct Brookhurst Road at grade across the Anaheim Branch of Union Pacific Railroad Company. The time for completion of the city's project was April 13, 1972, but since said project was never completed the above authority has expired.

By letter dated May 12, 1972, the city requests that said authority be reinstated and extended to December 31, 1972. The city further requests that said authorization provide for the installation of automatic crossing gates in lieu of the previously ordered flashing light signals.

IT IS ORDERED that said authority is hereby reinstated and extended to December 31, 1972.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the third and fourth sentences of the second paragraph of the order in Decision No. 76983 which now read as follows:

"Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Backlights may be omitted from the signals to be mounted on the center median."

are hereby amended to read as follows:

Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented by automatic crossing gates.
