SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Order in Decision No. 80219 dated July 11, 1972, authorized the applicant to construct an industrial spur track at grade across Orange Grove Avenue near the City of Sacramento in the County of Sacramento, at the location and substantially as shown by plans attached to the application to be identified as Crossing No. A-97.8-C. The Order also provides that protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with additional flashing light signals on cantilever arms, with the effective date to be twenty days after July 11, 1972.

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company by letter dated July 12, 1972, has informed the Commission that fire of undetermined origin destroyed offices and one-half of the facility of the industry to be served by this spur track. The industry is now in dire need of rail service at this location, and the applicant requests authority to commence construction immediately and be allowed to flag the crossing for an interim period of six months or until installation of the required automatic protection can be accomplished.

IT IS ORDERED that the fifth and seventh paragraphs of Decision No. 30219 are suspended for a period of six months from the date hereof. The applicant is authorized to construct the industrial spur track as authorized in Decision No. 30219, with interim protection to be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material and to flag the crossing for a period not to exceed six months from the date hereof or until the installation of the automatic protection can be accomplished.

In all other respects Decision No. 80219 shall remain in full force and effect. The effective date of this Order shall be the date hereof.
