Pacific Gas and Electric Company, in this proceeding, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the City of San Jose, permitting the installation, maintenance, and use of a gas distribution and transmission system in the streets of said city.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit A, was granted by the city in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937 and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the city equivalent to one per cent of the gross annual receipts from sales of gas within the limits of the city under said franchise, with provisions for modifying the rate of compensation under certain conditions.

The costs incurred by applicant in obtaining the franchise are stated to have been \$69.97, which amount does not include costs incident to this application.

Applicant has served gas in and about the City of San Jose without competition for many years. As of December 31, 1971, it served 144,600 customers within the city from approximately 1,331 miles of gas mains therein. No objection to the granting of the requested certificate has been received and a public hearing is not necessary.
