FINAL ORDER

Decision No. 30068, dated May 16, 1972 in this proceeding, is an interim order of the Commission, establishing a truckload exception rating of Class 35.3, subject to a minimum weight of 45,000 pounds and to several restrictive rules, on "Film or Sheeting, Plastic, other than cellulose" in Exception Ratings Tariff 1.

The exception rating was established on an interim basis in order to afford California Manufacturers Association an opportunity to present evidence concerning certain of the rules applicable to the exception rating. By letter dated June 27, 1972, California Manufacturers Association advised the Commission that said Association withdraws its opposition to the petition herein and will not object if the exception rating on plastic film and sheeting is established on a permanent basis. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the interim order in Decision No. 80068, dated May 16, 1972, in Case No. 7858, Petition No. 132, is hereby made the final order of the Commission in said proceeding.
