<u>ORDER</u>

City of San Diego is hereby authorized to replace the existing grade separation of 47th Street (Crossing No. 36D-5.2-B) and construct a temporary bridge on a shoofly alignment for use during construction, to be identified as Crossing No. 36D-5.21-B under the tracks of San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibits A,B,C and D) attached to the application, as amended.

Grade separation for 47th Street has been established as Priority No. 7 on the 1972 Grade Separation Priority List by Decision No. 79466 in Case No. 9257.

Clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Walkway areas adjacent to San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company's tracks shall be maintained free of obstructions and shall promptly be restored to their original condition in the event of damage during construction.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the City of San Diego and San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railway shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
