## ORDER DENYIVG CEASE AND DESIST <br> AND SERTING IMMEDIAIE REARING

Complainant alleges that he operates a passenger stage corporation between Sakersfield and the Kern County Alrport pursuant to a certificate of pubilc convenience and necessity is sued by this Comission. Ee further alleges that defendant is operating a competing passenger stage business, in that defendant meets ali. scheduled filghts at the aipport, solicits and charges on a per capita basis, and advertises his services. complainant requests an immediate order requiring defendant to cease and desist from this aetivity pending further order of the Commission.

The Commision is not satisfied that there is a sufifcient showing in the complaint to warrant the immediate extraordinary relief requested by complainant based solely on the pleading. However, the Comassion does belleve that this matter should be set for immediate hearing.

ORDER

Complainant's request for an immediate cease and desist order is denfed.

Eearings on this matter shall be held in the Caucus Room, City Eall, 1501 Truxtun Avenue, Bakersfield, California, on August 7, 1972, commencing at 2:00 P.M., and extending to August 8, 1972, if necessary, before Examinex Foley.
