ORDER DENYING CEASE AND DESIST
AND SETTING IMMEDIATE HEARING

Complainant alleges that he operates a passenger stage corporation between Bakersfield and the Kern County Airport pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. He further alleges that defendant is operating a competing passenger stage business, in that defendant meets all scheduled flights at the airport, solicits and charges on a per capita basis, and advertises his services. Complainant requests an immediate order requiring defendant to cease and desist from this activity pending further order of the Commission.

The Commission is not satisfied that there is a sufficient showing in the complaint to warrant the immediate extraordinary relief requested by complainant based solely on the pleading. However, the Commission does believe that this matter should be set for immediate hearing.

ORDER

Complainant's request for an immediate cease and desist order is denied.

Hearings on this matter shall be held in the Caucus Room, City Hall, 1501 Truxtun Avenue, Bakersfield, California, on August 7, 1972, commencing at 2:00 P.M., and extending to August 8, 1972, if necessary, before Examiner Foley.
