ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Payson Gregory, doing business as Gregory Warehouse Co., possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Fresno.

Payson Gregory informed the Commission by letter dated January 11, 1971, that, though he had lost his warehouse in a fire, he desired to retain his warehouse operative right so that he might sell it to an interested party. The Secretary of the Commission replied to Mr. Gregory stating that he would have to file annual reports for the years 1969 and 1970 in order to retain the right. To date, the annual reports for those years and 1971 have not been received.

Payson Gregory not having filed the required annual reports and apparently no longer operating as a public utility warehouseman, the Commission finds that such circumstances constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Payson Gregory, doing business as

Gregory Warehouse Co., for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Fresno as determined by the Commission's order dated August 9, 1960, in Case No. 6751, is hereby revoked.

2. Payson Gregory, doing business as Gregory Warehouse Co., Warehouse Tariff P.U.C. No. 2 is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Payson Gregory or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
