SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 79701, dated February 8, 1972, Central Coast Truck Service, Inc. was authorized to depart from the minimum rates in Minimum Rate Tariff 8 for the transportation of fresh carrots in bulk in collapsible bins from various points in California to Richmond and Sacramento for Safeway Stores, Incorporated. This authority was granted on a temporary basis pending a hearing. It is scheduled to expire August 8, 1972. A hearing has not yet been scheduled, and it appears that the present temporary authority should be extended a further three months to permit time for a public hearing.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted to Central Coast Truck Service, Inc., by Decision No. 79701, in Application No. 53114, is extended to November 8, 1972.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
