O P I N I O N

Reno Loyalton Calpine Stages, Inc. requests authority to abandon passenger stage service between the California-Nevada State Line and Clover Valley via Beckwith, Vinton, Chilcoot and Reno Junction.

The operating authority was acquired by applicant by Decision No. 41779, dated June 29, 1948, in Application No. 29431.

It is alleged that the operating authority was originally granted over fifty years ago; that for the past several years there has been no public demand for applicant's service despite the efforts by applicant to offer service; and that applicant is not now providing service because of the resulting economic loss.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service as a passenger stage corporation. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. After the effective date hereof Reno Loyalton Calpine Stages, Inc. may discontinue service as a passenger stage corporation.

2. The operating authority acquired by applicant by Decision No. 41779, dated June 29, 1948, in Application No. 29431, is hereby revoked and the tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission in the name of applicant are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
