Application of the State of California  
Department of Public Works for an order  
authorizing the construction of a cross-  
ing at separated grades, to be known as  
San Ysidro Underpass Bridge No. 57-770  
under the San Diego & Arizona Eastern  
Railway Company's mainline track, and  
the closing and removing of existing  
grade crossing at Mesa Avenue, PUC No.  
36-14.3, in the City of San Diego.

O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of San Ysidro Underpass under the tracks of San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36-14.33-B.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and a copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D. Walkway areas adjacent to the railroad tracks shall be maintained free of obstructions and shall promptly be restored to their original condition in the event of damage during construction.

Upon completion, the existing grade crossing of Mesa Avenue (Crossing No. 36-14.3) shall be abandoned and physically closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless the time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
