ORDER OF SUSPENSION

California Manufacturers Association filed on August 8, 1972, a petition for stay of order and rehearing or reconsideration of Decision No. 80314, dated July 25, 1972, insofar as the "released value" provisions of said decision would govern the authorized special volume incentive service rates.

Under the terms of Section 1733 of the Public Utilities Code, the effective date of the order is stayed until the petition is granted or denied. As information to interested parties affected a suspension supplement to Minimum Rate Tariff 2 will be issued by the order herein.
