SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

East Bay Drayage & Warehouse Co., by its application, filed March 6, 1972, requested that its operating authority be amended by excluding therefrom the transportation of hypochlorite solution and related commodities from Oakland.

By Decision No. 79863, dated March 23, 1972, the Commission granted the relief prayed for. Ordering paragraph 2 of the decision provided that: "Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted."

The effective date of the order was April 17, 1972 and the tariff filings were required to be made on or before June 17, 1972.

East Bay Drayage & Warehouse Co. has not made the required tariff filings.

Therefore good cause appearing the Commission finds that the authority granted by Decision No. 79868, dated March 28, 1972, should be rescinded.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decision No. 79868, dated March 28, 1972, in Application No. 53188 is hereby rescinded effective thirty days from the effective date of this order unless on or before such date the required tariff filings are made.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of this order to be made by certified mail upon East Bay Drayage & Warehouse Co.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
