SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 74807 Las Vegas Truck Line, Inc., a California corporation, was authorized to transfer, and Las Vegas Tank Lines, Inc., a Nevada corporation, was authorized to acquire, a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier. The application, and therefore the decision, made no reference to a petroleum irregular route certificate that was granted by Decision No. 55548 in Application No. 38932 and which was acquired by Las Vegas Truck Line, Inc. by Decision No. 60507, dated August 2, 1960, in Application No. 42338. The transfer as authorized by Decision No. 74807 was the result of an agreement entered into by the parties whereby the Nevada corporation acquired all of the outstanding stock of the California corporation.

On March 14, 1972, the Interstate Commerce Commission authorized the merger of the operating rights and property of the Las Vegas Tank Lines, Inc., doing business as Las Vegas Truck Line, the Nevada corporation, into Associated Freight Lines, a California corporation.

Applicants request an order of this Commission reflecting the fact that the operating authorities heretofore referred to, which were previously the property of Las Vegas Tank Lines, Inc., are now the property of Associated Freight Lines.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The name of Associated Freight Lines is hereby substituted for the names of Las Vegas Truck Line and Las Vegas Tank Lines, Inc. with respect to the operating authorities to which reference has heretofore been made.

2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof Associated Freight Lines shall amend the tariff presently on file with this Commission in the names of Las Vegas Tank Lines, Inc. and Las Vegas Truck Line, to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
