SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 79243, dated October 13, 1971, in this application, Harrison-Nichols Company, Ltd., was granted temporary authority to assess a rate less than the minimum for the transportation of processed silica sand from the Mission Viejo plant of Owens-Illinois Glass Company in San Juan Capistrano to Vernon. The authority was granted pending public hearing after operations commenced. Decision No. 79801, dated March 14, 1972, extended the authority to September 1, 1972.

The Mission Viejo plant still is not in full production. It appears, and the Commission finds, that the temporary authority should be further extended to March 1, 1973. ✓

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decision No. 79243, and extended by Decision No. 79801, in this proceeding, is further extended to expire with March 1, 1973. ✓

The effective date of this order shall be September 1, 1972.
